

# AFRICA: Burkina Faso (Phase 2) – Bobo-Dioulasso

## Supporting civil society & local state actors to prevent chronic malnutrition & child mortality in the Hauts-Bassins region in cooperation with the German Government BMZ



The project objective is to sustainably improve the nutritional situation of 3,000 very poor households with children aged 0-23 months (1,961) & pregnant women (1,503) in the community of Bama (7 villages with CSPS and most affected by malnutrition).

### Activities:

- ❖ Training in food preparation and local vegetable production
- ❖ Provision of poultry and seeds for vegetable cultivation
- ❖ Construction of the production facility for nutritional flour
- ❖ NUTRISCO, baby flour availability
- ❖ Training of mothers of children in the creation of micro-gardens and poultry farming
- ❖ Each of the 1,619 mothers of children received 1 rooster and 4 hens - a total of 1,619 roosters and 6,476 hens.

### Impact:

- ❖ the capacity of community actors for food security has been increased
- ❖ the nutritional status of 1,360 children, of 400 schoolchildren & 1,000 pregnant women and breastfeeding mothers was improved through the valorisation and promotion of local products
- ❖ the food rations available to the poor and very poor HH were increased by diversifying the agricultural products grown
- ❖ the capacities of local actors for the implementation of a sustainable nutrition policy were strengthened
- ❖ reduction chronic malnutrition by strengthening the community health system and nutrition-sensitive food production
- ❖ Improvement of resilience
