

FORGOTTEN CRISES

MAURETANIA – MYANMAR – BURUNDI

This project supports 3 countries:

1. Mauritania – Sahel Crises:

„Strengthening the resilience of Malian refugees in Mauritania“

Support measures for refugees in the Mbera camp who have fled Mali to improve their living conditions in the overcrowded camp.

- Identification of needs and site coordination
- Improving access to drinking water and strengthening WASH
- Construction of latrines
- School meals and income-generating activities for women
- Vegetable cultivation

2. Myanmar: „High-quality education and healthcare for the children of Hriphi“

There is no school or health centre in the hill village of Hriphi. The children walk ~10 kilometres to the nearest public school.

Construction of a accessible quality education and health care for the marginalised:

- Construction of a school, solar energy powered
 - Full equipment including IT classroom
 - Train qualified teachers
 - Construction of a sports field
 - Construction and equipping of a health centre
 - Employment of a qualified nurses
 - Paramedic training programme
- Ensuring adequate quality education & health care.

3. Burundi: „Supporting resilience: improving the livelihoods of extremely poor women in the Buganda community“

- Participatory identification of beneficiaries from among very needy women
 - Training on AGR (income-generating activities), social cohesion, community life, savings and financial management
 - Activities and training for savings and credit communities, distribution of equipment
- Promote income generation and improving the resilience of extremely poor women.
